WARM-UP LANE ASSIGNMENTS: (Please re-check lane assignments when you arrive at the pool).

Lanes 6-11 will be available for swim teams that want additional time for their swimmers to warm up at the same time the divers are warming up. During the diving competition, lanes 8-11 will be available for swimmers to warm up (leaving lanes 6-7 as a buffer so as not to interfere with the divers during their competition). There should be no one using the starting blocks to enter the pool at any time during the diving warm-up or diving competition. If a coach wants to get additional time doing racing starts during their assigned period, they have control of their lanes and can start that activity at their discretion. During the swimming portion of the competition, lanes 10-11 will be available to teams to use for warm-up/cool-down. We will leave lane 9 closed as a buffer to avoid interfering with the competition.

COACHES SCRATCH MEETING: 2 P.M. (or as soon as the diving competition is over)

ONE COACH OR REP NEEDS TO BE AT THIS MEETING. RELAY SLIPS WILL BE TURNED IN AT THIS TIME. Scratches only will be accepted when the teams arrive at the pool, no substitutions will be allowed. If a swimmer or diver has an illness or accident and can not compete, the coach will need to contact the entry chair/meet director no later than the day before the competition to make a change.

ENTRIES: Each team is allowed three (3) entries per event. Each swimmer is allowed four (4) entries, no more than two (2) of which may be, individual events.

ALL EVENTS WILL BE SWUM AS TIMED FINALS. DIVING IS CONSIDERED AS A SWIMMING EVENT.

RELAYS: Each school is allowed two (2) relay teams per event.

ENTRY SUBMISSION: Hy-Tek entries are to be submitted using the file posted on Swimmeet.com website. Entries on the enclosed entry sheet will be accepted but Hy-Tek is strongly encouraged to make sure that all swimmer information is correctly input. Please include Swimmer/Divers' first and last name, grade, sex and seed time, along with coach & school on the team roster sheet if you are not using Hy-Tek for your entries. All coaches will receive an entry report within 24 hours of the time they have submitted their entries. If a coach does not receive their entry report within that amount of time, assume that for whatever reason, your e-mail has not been received and contact the entry chair to work out an alternative method to send in your entries. Coaches are encouraged to send their entries in as early as possible. A psyche sheet will be posted on both the host team web site as well as being sent to the swimmeet.com website 24 hours after the last teams entries have been received. This will allow all coaches to review their entries and make any changes. Once the information has been posted on the swimmeet.com website, no more changes will be allowed to the individual entries other than scratches that can be made at the pool. Relay entries are encouraged to be submitted with the individual entries, but relay cards will be in the coaches package at the pool and changes to relays will be allowed until 30 minutes prior to the start of the first relay. Each team is allowed 3 entries per event. Each swimmer is allowed 4 events, no more than 2 of which may be individual events.

DIVING ENTRIES: Diving will consist of five dives (Twist – required, Front Position, Back Position and two optionals). Since diving is being competed at the beginning of the meet, we need to get all dive information into the computer system at the same time that the teams deliver their swim entries. This will

allow the dive sheets to be cross-checked by an official before the divers arrive at the pool and have the dives entered into the scoring system. The coaches should e-mail their divers information to the entry chair/meet director listing the name and numeric/alpha identifier for the competition (example: Diver name – 401B, 302C, 5122D, 103C). Dive sheets will be created for the divers using eDive software and ready for the divers and coaches to cross-check and sign when they arrive at the pool. Any changes to the dive list for each diver and scratches for divers who will not compete will be accepted at the computer table until 12:15PM the day of the meet. Please have all divers review their dive sheets and with both the divers and coaches signature on the dive sheet before starting their warm-ups. Diving is considered a swimming event.

FEES: Entry fee is \$50.00 per school entered into the meet.

OFFICIALS: On your entry form, please indicate the certified Ohio High School Swimming official that your team is providing to officiate the swim meet. **YOUR SCHOOL IS RESPONSIBLE FOR THAT INDIVIDUAL'S FEES.** The name of your schools official should be included as part of the e-mail when sending in your teams entries to allow us to determine which officials will work diving and the lead positions for swimming (referee, starter, chief judge).

TIMERS: Each team is responsible for providing two timers to work the meet. With the number of teams entered, we will be able to have two timers per lane, relief timers and still have some people available to help with posting results. Please have your workers report to the head timer during warm-ups for their lane assignments.

Championship results will be used to determine division split for the following season. The top 6 teams will be in the "A" division, and the bottom 6 teams will be in the "B" division. Championship records can only be broken at the league championship meet. Split times, as well as relay lead off swims, will count for records. Electronic timing must be used.

CONCESSIONS: A full concession stand will be available throughout the meet.

PARKING AND POOL ENTRY: Please have your teams park in the Mason High School parking lot and enter the pool area through the "Commons/Natatorium" doorway and not through the Mason Community Center. If your teams park in the High School parking lot, they would have to walk past the Natatorium door in order to get to the Community Center. No one should enter the Community Center portion of the facility unless they have a membership or have purchased a "day pass". This includes the dressing rooms in the Community Center. The high school dressing rooms will be available for the teams during the competition.

TRAINER: In case of an injury, there will be a trainer available at the pool.
