- A. Championship Format:** For this meet to ever be considered a championship meet, according to OHSAA we will need to go to the Championship Meet Format.
- B. DIVING:** Saturday 1:00. Please include divers in your team manager entries. Please have diving sheets filled out prior to starting warm ups. Each team is permitted a maximum of 4 girl and 4 boy divers.
- C. No Shows:** must be declared false starts or the contestant will be disqualified from the rest of the meet (Championship format)
- D. Heat Sheets** \$2.00 heat sheets will be available for sale at the admissions
Senior Bios will be included in the heat sheet Three heat sheets will be provided for each school
- E. Scoring** will be 9-7-6-5-4-3-2-1 and Relays are Doubled -
Only four individuals per event and one A relays can score (**Championship format scoring**)
- F. TIMERS:**
Each team must supply **timers**; “timers will not be charged admission”

F. Entry Limitations: Each team will be permitted 4 entries per individual event with the exception of the 50 and 100 free which are unlimited (but can only score 4 per team, your top 4 seeded swimmers) and 2 relay entries “of which only the A-Relay can score” *The only reason we are allowing more than four entries for the 50 & 100 free is so teams can get all of their swimmers in the meet.*
(FYI championship format only allows 4 entries per event)

Relay Entries: Each team is permitted 2 of each relay, but only the A-Relay can score.
“Championship format only allows one of each relay entry, we are allowing 2 to swim to get more athletes in the relay events”
