Friends of the Classic Foundation -- 2024 Scholarship Grant Application Instructions

1. Criteria for the Friends of the Classic Scholarship Grant (Priority Order)

- Personal Impact - What impact the applicant has had on the sport of swimming or diving and what impact the sport has had on the applicant.
- Community Involvement/Leadership (what impact the applicant has had on their school, community, team, family, friends).
- Need (who in final consideration would benefit most from the award).

2. Basic Requirements

- Applicant must have participated in high school swimming/diving for at least 2 years.
- Applicant must have participated in the Classic for 2 years, 1 of which must be the senior year.
- Applicant must be a senior in good academic standing at their high school, and in good standing with their community.
- Applicant must successfully complete senior year and maintain good standing in their community prior to entering college. Failure will result in forfeiture of the Grant.

3. Awards and Amounts

- In 2024, we will award 6 scholarships (3 men, 3 women) in the amount of \$750. The Friends of the Classic Foundation may award no more than 6 equal grants evenly among men and women.

4. Selection Committee

- The Committee that decides the recipients of each year's scholarships will consist of 7 individuals:
 - 3 Coaches: Swimming:1-South, 1-North, 1-Diving
 - 3 Officials: 1-at large, 1-North, 1-South
 - 1 Administrator
- The Secretary of the Friends of the Classic Foundation will Chair the Selection Committee.
- The Selection Committee will strive for diversity, geographical balance, and diving representation.
