#### INFORMATION:

2024 marks the 40<sup>th</sup> anniversary for the Southwest Classic which remains the largest invitational of its kind in the United States. Forty-one years ago, the preliminaries & finals took place at one location, Keating Natatorium at St. Xavier High School. This meet now has 11 preliminary sites. Approximately 112 schools entering over 2450 swimmers and 165 divers are expected to participate in this year's Classic. The Classic is unusual because the swimmers compete not only in high school events but also the longer NCAA & USA Swimming events. This year the Classic will continue to include Para swimming events in the 50 Freestyle and 100 Backstroke. The Southwest Ohio Swimming Officials Association (SWOSOA) continues to sponsor this meet through the Southwest Classic Swim Meet, LLC. Through meet proceeds, donations & sponsor advertising, SWOSOA has established an athlete scholarship fund and for the twelfth year will be offering six \$750 scholarships to three senior boys and three senior girls this year. Luca Eckert (*St. Xavier*), Ryan Eshler (*Waynesville*), Logan Ottke (*Cincinnati Hills Christian Academy*), Ryleigh Brown (*Kenton Ridge*), Hannah Rachford (*West Clermont*), and Ava Sutphin (*Turpin*) were the 2023 recipients.

St. Xavier will be competing for its  $40^{th}$  straight boys' team title. Names to watch in this year's Classic are:

The Southwest District has earned the right to be called "The District of Champions." It has produced some of the top swimmers in the state and last year was no exception. In Boys Division I, St. Xavier finished 1<sup>st</sup> in the State while Mason finished 6<sup>th</sup>. Thirty (30) boys from this area finished in the top ten in their events. Southwest boys won 5 of the 12 individual & relay events. For Division II, St. Indian Hill finished 2<sup>nd</sup> at State while Dayton Oakwood finished 4<sup>th</sup>. Twenty-four (24) boys from this area finished in the top ten in their events. Southwest boys won 7 of the 12 individual & relay events.

In girls' competition, St. Ursula finished 4<sup>th</sup> in the State for Division I while Mason finished 7<sup>th</sup>, Walnut Hills finished 9<sup>th</sup> and Kings Mills 10<sup>th</sup>. Twenty-five (25) girls from this area finished in the top 10 in

their events. Southwest girls won 3 of the 12 individual & relay events. For Division II, Kettering Alter finished  $3^{rd}$  while Mariemont finished  $5^{th}$ , Indian Hill  $7^{th}$ , & Cincinnati Hills Christian Academy  $9^{th}$ . Twenty-three (23) girls from this area finished in the top 10 in their events. Southwest girls won 2 of the 12 individual & relay events.

The Ohio High School State Meet Swimming & Diving Records show how strong Southwest District swimmers have been over the years. Southwest District swimmers & divers hold 26 of the 36 meet records (10 in Boys Div. I event, 8 in Boys Div. 2 events, 5 in Girls Div. I event, & 3 in Girls Div. II events). These names have been and will be prominent in college and world competitions.
