This meet is a sanctioned **USA swimming event** and times will be uploaded to swims database. Please make sure if you have USA swimmers that their ID is with the entries to make certain they get the credit for their swims. It would also be helpful to have the swimmers full name on the entries.

There will also be a handful of individual events and a relay for JR High swimmers for those of you who have JR High swimmers. They will also have a 4 entry limit which would include the relay if entered. The Jr High events are the 100 and up event numbers.

Entry Fees: Entry Fees will be \$18.00 per swimmer includes relays. I will provide a Team fee report as requested for those who need them to process the check.

Entry Limitations: Each participant is permitted to enter a maximum of four (4) events. Each team may enter up to 5 individuals in each event and up to 3 relays.

Medical Forms: Please be sure that you have access to Medical Information Forms for all swimmers during all competition.

Bus/Van Parking: All buses and team vans are to park in the lot on the east end of the complex, near the back, to allow for worker and spectator parking.

Facility Entry: All teams, and coaches are to enter the Spire Aquatics entrance on the southwest side of the complex, the door is marked.

Team Areas: PLEASE NO PARENTS ON DECK !!

Locker Rooms: Both the male and female locker rooms will be available for restroom use. All clothing and personal items must be kept in the team camp area. Access to the locker rooms will be from the pool deck.

NEITHER MEET MANAGEMENT NOR THE SPIRE INSTITUTE WILL BE RESPONSIBLE FOR PERSONAL BELONGINGS.

Scoring: Scoring for this invitational will be for the top 13 places in relay events and 8 places in individual events. Scoring is as follows:

Relays: 20-17-16-15-13-11-9-7-6-5-4-3-1

Individual events: 10-8-7-6-4-3-2-1

Scratches: Scratches need to be received by Thursday January 9th if possible, I would like to pre seed the meet in hopes of smooth morning.

Admissions: \$8.00 adults, \$6.00 students

Food: Concessions will be available at Spire Fuel and available vending machines. No outside food or beverages allowed (water only). No food permitted in the natatorium.

Please Note: The Spire pool has two bulkheads in its pool. Swimming under it or in the area between it is prohibited. Violators are subject to meet disqualification. Please remind team members!!! Coaches are required to supervise their athletes during the warm up sessions.

Representation: No team or individual will be allowed to compete in the Invitational unless a coach or person authorized by the related school's Board of Education is present throughout the meet. Teams and individual entries unaccompanied by such a school representative will be disqualified.

Code of Conduct: During participation in OHSAA contest any student or coach ejected for unsportsmanlike conduct shall be ineligible for the remainder of that day as well as for the next two contests.

Falcon Invitational Meet Coaches Meeting Notes & Safety Rules

- There will be a swim coaches meeting in the pool office with officials before the start of the meet.
- The pool office will receive all medical emergencies and first-aid needs. See lifeguard.
- Scratches will be taken at the computer table in the pool office. These must be done at least 30 minutes prior to the start of the meet. Please remember that the swimmer's coach is the only person allowed to scratch a swimmer.
