2001 SWIMMING AND DIVING TOURNAMENT ENTRY REGULATIONS

- 1.Event entry forms and team entry forms are available through your Athletic Director(in the back of the 2000-2001 high School directory). Eligibility lists are also available through your Athletic Director.
- 2. January 22, 2001 is the THIRTY (30) DAY CUT-OFF FOR INDEPENDENT SWIMMING.
- 3. A school that actually competes in at least two interscholastic meets as a school team prior to the non-interscholastic cutoff date (January 22,2001) is eligible for relay event entry at the Sectional District tournament regardless of the number of individuals entered and competing.
- 4. Each school shall be permitted four (4) entries in each individual event and one (1) team in each relay event with no cut-off times.
- 5. A competitor shall be permitted to participate in a maximum of four (4) events, no more than two (2) of which may be individual events.
- 6. Relay team members may be changed from the Sectional to the District to the State Tournament provided swimmers are on the school's tournament eligibility list and will not have participated in more events than permitted by the federation rules (Rule 3, Section 2, Article 2, See Note). Names of up to eight individuals and the notation of those who are actually competing on the relay are to be listed on the relay cards which are then to be turned in at the appropriate time on the day of competition
- 7. In championship meets, a competitor officially becomes a participant in an individual event when the official entry form is delivered to the meet manager at the specified time and place. (Rule 3 Sec 2 Art. 2)
- 8. National Federation Swimming/Diving Rules stipulates that a team consists of one (1) or more competitors. Therefore, any school entering individuals in the Swimming/Diving Tournament is eligible for team point scoring. (Rule 1 Section 4 Article 1)
- 9. For the boys, the Anderson, Centerville, Keating and Springfield sites will each have two (2) automatic qualifiers and the next twenty-four (24) at large qualifiers for a field of thirty-two (32) in individual events. For relay events, there will be two (2) automatic qualifiers from each site plus sixteen (16) additional at large qualifiers for a field of twenty- four (24). In addition, any individual or relay team with a faster time than the last automatic qualifier will be permitted to compete in the District. Boy divers from the Anderson, Keating and the combined Centerville/Springfield sites will each qualify two (2) divers for a total of six (6) automatic qualifiers. In addition eighteen (18) divers based on scores will also qualify for a field of twenty-four (24).

The District Tournament will qualify three (3) in each swimming event to the State Meet, with eleven (11) additional State qualifiers chosen at large on the basis of times recorded in the district meets around the state. Six (6) divers will qualify to the State Meet.

10. **Division I Girls:** The Centerville and Keating Sectionals will each have two (2) automatic qualifiers plus a total of twenty-eight (28) at large qualifiers for a field of thirty-two (32) in individual events. For relay events, each site will have two (2) automatic qualifiers plus a total of twenty (20) at large qualifiers for a field of twenty-four (24). In **addition, any individual or relay team with a faster time than the last automatic qualifier will be permitted to compete in the District.** The sectionals at Centerville and Keating will qualify two (2) automatic divers each, plus a total of twenty (20) additional divers based on score for a field of twenty-four (24) qualifying to the District Tournament.

The Division I District Tournament will qualify four (4) in each swimming event to the State Meet, with an additional eleven (11) additional State qualifiers chosen at large on the basis of times recorded in the district meets around the state, Seven (7) divers will qualify to the State Meet.

11. **Division II Girls:** The Wittenberg and Keating sectionals will each have two (2) automatic qualifiers plus a total of twenty (20) at large qualifiers for a field of twenty-four (24) at the District Tournament. For relay events, each site will have two (2) automatic qualifiers plus a total of twelve (12) at large qualifiers for a field of sixteen (16). In addition, **any individual or relay team with a faster time than the last automatic qualifier will be permitted to compete in the District.** The sectionals at Wittenberg and Keating will qualify two (2) automatic divers each, plus a total of twenty (20) additional divers based on score for a field of twenty-four (24) qualifying to the District Tournament.

The Division II District Tournament will qualify three (3) in each swimming event tot he State Tournament, with eleven (11) additional State qualifiers chosen at large on the basis of times recorded in the district meets around the state. Six (6) divers will qualify to the State Tournament.

SECTIONAL ENTRY VIA COMPUTER

Since the 2001 EasyWare EasyEntry computer program now provides the capability of printing your entries in a spreadsheet/grid format which emulates the official OHSAA entry form, we have received approval from the state to use this printout as the official form. This printout will provide you with a better means of proof-reading your data entry, save time, effort, duplication and the chance of clerical error between forms.

Please do the following in order to use this as your means of entry:

Go to the web site (www.swimmeet.com) and access the sectional information.

Following the instructions, download the entry program (this is specific for sectionals). Follow instructions regarding date entry.

The OHSAA entry form is available on the web for use as a worksheet.

Upon completion of data entry, print the spreadsheet/grid (Select the desired option in the "Grid" section of the "Print" window, and then hit "Print".

A Hy-tek print-out IS NOT acceptable in lieu of the official entry form.

Your entry disc is to be brought to the sectional meeting on Feb. 1, along with your printout which you are to sign.

Additionally, since the computer printout does not include demographic information, you are to download the checklist, complete and attach to your spreadsheet.

Thus the entry submission is accomplished by providing an EasyEntry spreadsheet printout plus an EasyEntry file on diskette.

OR

The entry submission is accomplished by providing an official OHSAA event entry form plus a Hytek file on diskette and a completed checklist.
