#### 2007 SWIMMING AND DIVING TOURNAMENT ENTRY REGULATIONS

1. OHSAA Team Entry, Eligibility Sheets and the event entry program to download are available at the website, <u>www.ohsaa.org.</u>

# 2. January 22, 2007 is the THIRTY (30) DAY CUT-OFF FOR INDEPENDENT SWIMMING.

3. A school that actually competes in at least two interscholastic meets as a school team prior to the noninterscholastic cut-off date (January 22, 2007) is eligible for relay event entry at the Sectional District tournament regardless of the number of individuals entered and competing.

4. Each school shall be permitted four (4) entries in each individual event and one (1) team in each relay event with no cut-off times.

5. A competitor shall be permitted to participate in a maximum of four (4) events, no more than two (2) of which may be individual events.

6. Relay team members may be changed from the Sectional to the District to the State Tournament provided swimmers are on the school's tournament eligibility list and will not have participated in more events than permitted by the federation rules (Rule 3, Section 2, Article 2, See Note). Names of up to eight individuals and the notation of those who are actually competing on the relay are to be listed on the relay cards which are then to be turned in at the appropriate time on the day of competition

7. In championship meets, a competitor officially becomes a participant in an individual event when the official entry form is delivered to the meet manager at the specified time and place. (Rule 3 Sec 2 Art. 2)

A SWIMMER OR DIVER MUST DECLARE A FALSE START (PRIOR TO THE EVENT OR HEAT) IN ORDER TO SWIM WITHOUT A PENALTY OTHER THAN A DISQUALIFICATION FOR THAT EVENT.

# A COACH MAY DECLARE A FALSE START FOR ANY ATHLETE IN THE COMPETITION. IF THERE IS A 'NO SHOW' IN AN EVENT (WITHOUT A DECLARED FALSE START), THE ATHLETE WILL NOT BE PERMITTED TO COMPETE IN SUBSEQUENT EVENTS.

National Federation Swimming/Diving Rules stipulates that a team consists of one (1) or more competitors.
Therefore, any school entering individuals in the Swimming/Diving Tournament is eligible for team point scoring. (Rule 1 Section 4 Article 1)

9. For the boys, the Centerville, Keating, Mason and Springfield sites will each have two (2) automatic qualifiers and the next twenty-four (24) at large qualifiers for a field of thirty-two (32) in individual events. For relay events, there will be two (2) automatic qualifiers from each site plus sixteen (16) additional at large qualifiers for a field of twenty- four (24). In addition, any individual or relay team with a faster time than the last automatic qualifier will be permitted to compete in the District. Boy divers from the Keating, Mason and the combined Centerville/Springfield sites will each qualify two (2) divers for a total of six (6) automatic qualifiers. In addition eighteen (18) divers based on scores will also qualify for a field of twenty-four (24).

The District Tournament will qualify three (3) in each swimming event to the State Meet, with eleven (11) additional State qualifiers chosen at large on the basis of times recorded in the district meets around the state. Six (6) divers will qualify to the State Meet.

10. **Division I Girls:** The Centerville, Keating and Mason Sectionals will each have two (2) automatic qualifiers plus a total of twenty-six (26) at large qualifiers for a field of thirty-two (32) in individual events. For relay events, each site will have two (2) automatic qualifiers plus a total of eighteen (18) at large qualifiers for a field of twenty-four (24). In addition, any individual or relay team with a faster time than the last automatic qualifier will be permitted to compete in the District. The sectionals at Centerville, Keating and Mason will qualify two (2) automatic divers each, plus a total of eighteen (18) additional divers based on score for a field of twenty-four (24) qualifying to the District Tournament.

The Division I District Tournament will qualify four (4) in each swimming event to the State Meet, with an additional eleven (11) additional State qualifiers chosen at large on the basis of times recorded in the district meets around the state, Seven (7) divers will qualify to the State Meet.

- a) Schools with less than 7 individuals may submit event entries on the OHSAA-provided paper event entry forms or by computer program. The OHSAA-provided forms must be delivered to the Entry Chairman with the other OHSAA forms or an electronic copy emailed to the Entry Chairman (<u>d.h.murray@sbcglobal.net</u>)
- b) Schools with 7 or more individuals are required to submit event entries by computer program. Hy-Tek Team Manager II is the required computer program for Sectional entries.
- OHSAA-provided paper event entry forms:
  - a) Official entry for schools with less than 7 individuals and not submitting a computer file.
  - b) Information must be typed.
  - c) Include relay swimmers not competing in individual events and place "R" in/near relay column.
  - d) Entries must be to the hundredth of a second.
  - e) Divers must be listed.

Computer Entry:

- a) Official entry for schools with swim teams or schools with less than 7 individuals and submitting a computer file. Verification of the computer file is the school's responsibility.
- b) Computer files must be emailed to the Entry Manager (<u>d.h.murray@sbcglobal.net</u>). Computer files received prior to February 4, 2007 will be imported into Hy-Tek Meet Manager and a team entry list returned by email. Corrections or minor changes will be accepted prior to the 4:00 p.m., Sunday, February 4, 2007 entry deadline. Corrections or minor changes must be in writing. If a new computer file is submitted, it will be the official entry and no listing will be returned for coaches' verification.
- c) Hy-Tek Team Manager II:
