Meet: *The meet will be conducted using Fly-Over Starts. When swimmers finish a heat, they are to remain in the water until the next heat is started.*

Meet

- Information:**
- A. All participants must be eligible under the rules of the OHSAA.
 - B. All coaches/representatives should read and understand the regulations for swimming meets which is published by the OHSAA on the Web Site.
 - C. This meet shall be for *swimming competition only. All diving competition will be held at another location at another date and time.*
 - D. Entry cut-off times will not be required.
 - E. Each school shall be permitted four (4) entries in each individual event and two (2) entries in each relay event.
 - F. An individual may be entered in no more than two (2) individual events. At the coaches meeting, no additions or substitutions shall be made.
 - G. An individual shall be permitted to participate in a maximum of four (4) events, no more than two (2) of which shall be individual events.
 - H. In relay events, eight (8) individuals may be listed as entrants, any four (4) may participate. Certification in the relay shall not count as an entry unless the individual actually competes in the event.

- I. Like last year, the girls and boys events will be contested in the same session.
- J. The meet shall be a timed final championship meet.
- K. Championship scoring for twelve (12) places will be followed.
- L. A team trophy shall be awarded to the first place team.
- M. The official coach/school representative must be with their team/swimmer(s) at all times. This shall include the entire warm-up period and all competition. If it is determined that the coach/school representative is not in attendance at any time, the team and all swimmers will be disqualified from further competition.
- N. Coaches/school representatives are to pickup admission passes at the main entrance of the natatorium. Competitors will be admitted to the warm-up session only upon presentation of contestants passes. Only the designated coach will be permitted to receive the contestant passes. Non-competing team members, cheerleaders, timers, stats, significant others, etc. must purchase admission tickets. (\$6 - adult; \$4 - student).
- O. No air horns or noise making devices will be permitted in the natatorium. Official School Banners will be permitted; however, other banners and signs of any type will not be permitted. The use of video taping equipment must adhere to OHSAA policy.
- P. Only certified high school coaches or reps, swimmers, meet officials and meet timers will be permitted on the pool deck during the meet warm-up and/or competition. The pool deck is defined as the concrete area on the lower level within 10' of the edge of the pool. Anyone violating this rule will have their swimmer(s) disqualified. **IMPORTANT: ALL COMPETITORS AND TEAM PERSONNEL MAY NOT SIT IN THE SPECTATOR AREA BUT MUST REMAIN IN THE AREA DESIGNATED FOR COMPETITORS ON THE LOWER LEVEL. THERE IS LIMITED SPECTATOR SEATING.**
- Q. Scoring will be as follows:
 - Relays: 32, 26, 24, 22, 20, 18, 14, 10, 8, 6, 4, 2
 - Individuals: 16, 13, 12, 11, 10, 9, 7, 5, 4, 3, 2, 1
- Q. All swimmers, including relay swimmers, must stay behind the timers before and after they swim.
- S. Locks must be supplied by individuals using lockers and shall not remain on the locker after the meet. Neither the Worthington High Schools (Thomas Worthington & Worthington Kilbourne) nor the meet management will be responsible for lost or stolen personal items or valuables.
- T. Each school is asked to handle its own discipline and litter problems. Any contestant or team found guilty of vandalism, theft, or conduct unbecoming to an athlete will be barred from further competition.

Entries: A. All entries must be submitted electronically using Hy-Tek Team Manager files by **4:00 pm Monday, January 23, 2017. Entries must be e-mailed to the e-mail address listed below:**

DO NOT FAX ENTRIES. FAXED ENTRIES WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED.

A Hy-Tek Events file is attached for use in your Team Manager Program. If you do not get the meet file via e-mail, e-mail a message regarding the meet file to the address above.

- B. Each and every competitor must be listed in the events the competitor will be swimming. Additions/deletions shall not be made after 4:00 pm., January 23, 2017.
- C. Entry times must be listed in the events the competitor will be swimming. If a competitor does not have an entry time, they shall be entered with a "no time " (NT).
