Rules: This meet will be conducted per 2024-25 NFHS and OHSAA Rules. There will be a 10-minute break after the 50 freestyle events. Diving will not be contested.

Scoring: Individual events – 14-11-10-9-8-6-4-3-2-1 | Relay events – 28-22-20-18-16-12-8-6-4-2. Only one relay per team in each relay event will score.

Awards: Medals will be awarded to the top three places of each event. Ribbons will be awarded for 4th through 10th place of each event. The highest scoring girls' team and highest scoring boys' team will be awarded a trophy and named SEOSL Champion. All-SEOSL status will be given to swimmers who finish in the top 3 places in individual and relay events.
