| <b>MEET</b>     | Meet details can be found on swimmeet.com. DI and DII meets will be contested concurrently, with a DII event followed immediately by the corresponding DI event.  |   |
| <b>PLACE</b>    | Mason High School Competition Pool<br>6100 South Mason-Montgomery Road, Mason, OH 45040<br><b>Both competitors &amp; spectators use the entrance under the covered walkway marked “Theater &amp; Natatorium”.</b> |   |
| <b>FACILITY</b> | <b>POOL</b>   | The Mason pool is an eleven lane, 25 yard pool. The eight (8) lanes nearest to the spectator seating area are equipped with starting blocks and a Colorado timing/starting system/scoreboard and are used for competition.<br>Lane 9 is used for pre-meet warm-up but is not to be used during the meet.<br>Lanes 10 & 11 are used during the meet for warm-up / cool-down. |
|                 | <b>TEAM AREA</b>  | Team areas will be available in deck bleachers, first come first served.<br><br>Each head coaches is responsible to ensure that the team area is clean before departure.  |
|                 | <b>DECK ACCESS</b>  | Only the coaches and athletes who are participating in the meet will be permitted on the pool deck,   |
|                 | <b>LOCKER ROOM</b>  | Full locker & shower rooms. Use the locker rooms on the high school side. Do not allow your teams to use the community center facilities.   |
|                 | <b>SEATING</b>  | Poolside capacity for more than 700 spectators  |
|                 | <b>COMMONS</b>  | The commons area just inside the building entrance is <b>AREA</b> available for spectators and competitors to relax during lulls between their events. It is a large space with open areas, tables, and chairs.   |
|                 | <b>PARKING</b>  | Park only in the high school lots. When you are facing the Natatorium entrance, the high school lots are located to your right (west & south of the high school building). <b><u>Do not park on the circle, north of the Natatorium near the community center, or at the municipal building.</u></b>  |
|                 | <b>OFF LIMITS</b>   | <b>The community center abuts the high school Natatorium across the pool from spectator seating and is separated from the competition pool by a glass door. NO ONE is permitted beyond the glass door to the community center pool, locker rooms, or any other facilities.</b>  |

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### PRE-MEET WARM-UP

### IN-MEET WARM-UP/ COOL-DOWN

During the competition, lanes 10 & 11 will be available for swimmers to use for warm - up / cool-down. Lane 9 will not be used, providing a buffer to minimize interference with the competitors in lanes 1-8. All swimmers must enter and leave warm-up/cool-down lanes in the northeast corner of the pool closest to the glassed-in office. Swimmers are not to jump or dive into the warm-up/cool-down area.
